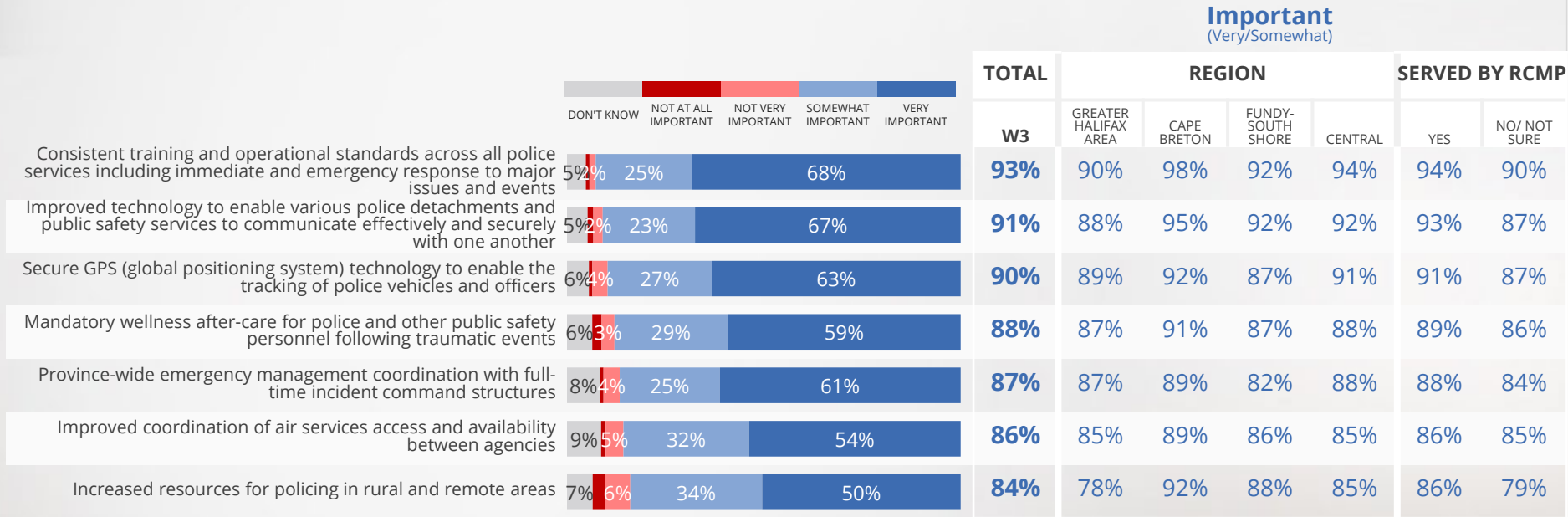


# National Police Federation – Nova Scotia Wave 3

# All seven measures to address gaps in policing seen as important by at least 6-in-7 Nova Scotians

- Majority of Nova Scotians see each of the proposed measures as “very important” ranging from 50% (increased resources) to 68% (consistent training and operational standards)

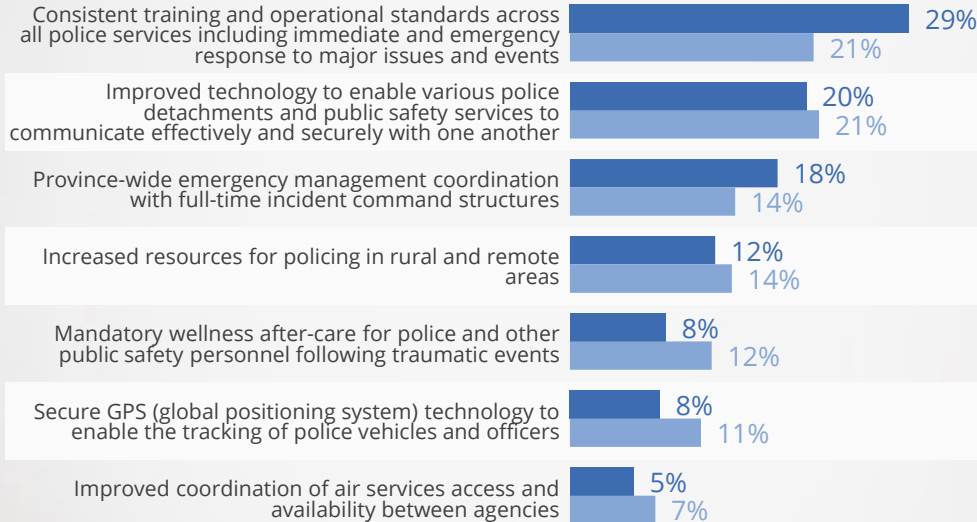


# Consistent training and operational standards is top priority to address policing gaps

- About half (49%) ranked consistent training and operational standards as 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> most important priority among measures provided
- Improved technology (41%) and emergency management coordination/incident command (32%) were next highest

# Methodology

- **Sampling:** Online survey of randomly selected sample of **1,005 adult (18+) Nova Scotia Residents**
- **Field Window: July 13 – 25, 2022**
  - This is the **3rd wave** of this study. Each wave includes a core set of tracking questions as well as new questions.
    - Wave 2 of study (N=1,005) conducted Jan 18 – 27, 2022
    - Wave 1 of study (N=1,003) conducted March 5 – 11, 2021
- **Reliability:** Non-probability samples cannot be assigned a margin of error. \*As a relative guideline, we have provided margins of error for a probability sample of this size. Data has been weighted by region, age and gender to be representative of the population of Nova Scotia

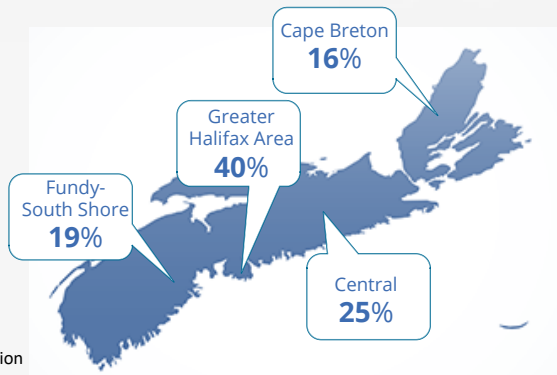

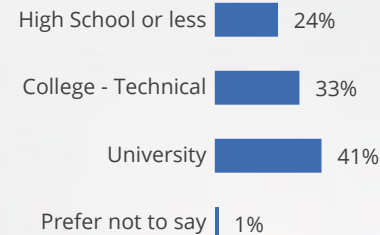

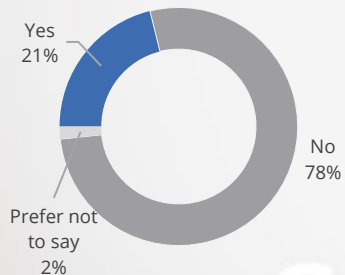

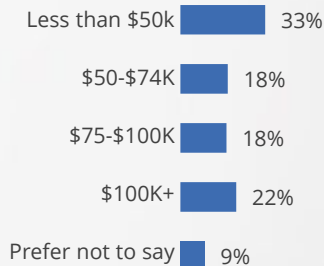
